## APPROVAL OF AGENDA AND PRIOR MINUTES

## **ONGOING BUSINESS and COMMITTEE REPORTS**

### **PRINCIPAL'S REPORT: Tierney Cahill**

- The Governor's Office yesterday awarded IHS the Governor's STEM school. Thanks to IEF!
  Opportunities for grants and funding. Tierney highlighted our amazing teachers, and the
  Governor was very complimentary. IMS will apply next year. IES received the award as well.
  Once IMS receives STEM designation, Incline will be the first vertical (K-12) to have the STEM
  award. UNR, TMCC asking to partner with dual credit classes and internships.
- Sara to share IEF email about the STEM award.
- Hispanic Parent Night tonight. Thanks to Lourdes for her help with this. Part of the vision to include the Hispanic Community.
- Facilities update: going out to bid. Will go to the Board for approval on June 27th, then WCSD will break ground on July 5th. Just focusing on the building; it's not including the field improvements. Mr. Harrison has submitted work orders to maintain the field.
- Diane plans to show the "Every 15 MInutes" video next Friday the 26th at Advisory, for Seniors only. This may be Senior ditch day. Possibly move the showing to 25th.
- Would like to create "Every 15 Minutes" live next year. Need to start planning by October.
- Discussion about a drug incident at IHS. Admin has several Narcan doses on hand. Quest Counseling recommended by Damonte Ranch, but they are not available right now. Staff has procedures for emergencies. School psychologist was brought in the next day. Must have probable cause to check backpacks/lockers. Lourdes recommends a trace detection system that's a test kit with swabs to monitor for drugs.
- Informative Drug Awareness day for students on May 25th in assembly.
- Mr. Murdock retires next year. Mr. Nolan will potentially retire.
- Graduation...well oiled machine. Parents can provide flowers & balloons. Boosters bring refreshments.



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## **PRESIDENT REPORT (Khal):**

- Finishing year end report.

**TREASURER REPORT (Alyssa):** Alyssa emailed her Treasurer report on 5/15/23 the FY2023 Budget vs. Actuals.

- Budgeted 18k for ATypical; came in at 20k. Tom suggests breaking out Crab Feed as its own Profit & Loss. It's difficult getting details for income because they come in a lump sum to the bank. It's difficult reconciling Greater Giving numbers and Quickbooks due to credit card fees, etc. Greater Giving provides income summaries; Atypical provides the event summary for expenses.

- Fund A Need from prior years causes current year's budget to overrun. It's a timing difference.

- No Red Ink was on the FAN list. Boosters approved to take funding out of FAN and make it an operating expense.

#### \*\*\*\*\*

An **interim email on May 1, 2023** motioned for the <u>No More Red Ink</u> funding approval, with Board members voting via email that same day.

**OUTCOME:** Alyssa motions to approve \$5406 for <u>No More Red Ink</u>, a Language Arts Curriculum. It will be included in the Textbooks budget line-item moving forward. Sara seconds the motion.
