For those interested in Fall Athletics, tryouts will begin on August 5th. To participate, your scholar athlete must be cleared through Register My Athlete and attend the tryouts. Please make sure athletes have their pink slips to confirm clearance. There have been some changes in the athletic fees due to a district-wide increase in the impact fee, making the base athletic fee \$100. Additional individual sports may have a spirit pack fee. I'm thrilled to share some exciting developments regarding our school's expansion. Thanks to the generous support from the Dave & Cheryl Duffield Foundation, we'll be adding new facilities and amenities. The ROTC building will soon be removed, making way for a new space on the first floor of the expansion. The second floor will house a state-of-the-art student-run restaurant and a Culinary Arts classroom, while the third floor will feature a student hub for studying, presentations, and gatherings. Construction will impact us this year, and I ask for your patience, understanding, gratitude, and perspective as we grow and improve our facilities.

As we approach the new school year, here are a few important dates to mark in your calendars:

Student IDs will be taken as part of school pictures on 8/31 & 9/1, with make-ups on 10/17.

New parking permits are required for student drivers. They cost \$5 and can be purchased from our bookkeeper, Ms. Barbara Loeschner. Seniors, juniors, and sophomores will have designated parking areas, so please respect each other, and follow the guidelines.

The Class of 2027 and all new I.H.S. students are invited to an orientation on August 18th at 11:00 a.m. in the theater. You'll receive your schedules in advance, so you can familiarize yourself with the campus and classroom locations. Regarding our Senior Class of 2024, our graduation date is scheduled for Monday, June 17th at 4:00 p.m. While the ceremony has traditionally been held in the gym, we're exploring the possibility of an outdoor ceremony. However, this is ultimately a district decision, and we'll keep you informed about any updates. More information for senior parents will be provided in the coming months.

As part of our ongoing commitment to safety, we are implementing significant security measures during the construction expansion project. We are pleased to announce the addition of two School Resource Officers, Deputy Heather Fisher and Deputy Hannah DeGoey, through a partnership with the Washoe County Sheriff's Office, funded by a grant from the Dave and Cheryl Duffield Foundation.

For our new families, I highly encourage you to join the Boosters organization. They play an invaluable role in supporting our school community through funding and volunteering. Whether you have time, talent, or resources to donate, there are many ways to get involved. Feel free to
